Short term support after hospital stay



Support Options Hospital to Home



A hospital stay can be a challenging time. Following discharge, support services can assist with recovery at home.

The Hospital to Home program can provide short term support for people

- Aged 65+ (or 50 years+ for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people) who are frail, aged or have dementia
- Aged under 65 who have a diagnosed disability

Services may include

- domestic assistance (*home care*)
- personal care
- home maintenance
- respite

Support Options will

- Discuss your needs with you and arrange required services
- Ask for consent for collection of personal information for provision of service
- Keep personal information private and confidential
- Welcome feedback so we can provide the best support possible
- Offer referrals to alternative services, if Support Options cannot meet your needs
- Inform you if a fee applies.
