Guiding separated families to healthier relationships

Family Relationship Services at Upper Murray Family Care (UMFC) provide impartial and objective assistance to families impacted by separation and/or divorce.



Using a child-focused and non-judgemental lens, we encourage parents to reduce conflict and resolve differences as they move through separation phases and beyond.

In suitable cases, this may involve parental consultations that include children, allowing their views to be heard. We also provide access to therapeutic group sessions for children experiencing family separation.

Our ultimate aim is to develop parenting arrangements in the best interests of children, and to foster healthy ongoing relationships between children, parents, and other family members.

Access to our programs can be voluntary or may be court-ordered.





Encouraging resolution through child-centred approaches

UMFC's **Family Relationship Centre** helps families affected by separation to agree on parenting arrangements that focus on what's best for their children. Families are supported in discussing issues and reaching agreement through dispute resolution, rather than having to attend court. Property dispute resolution is also offered as an alternative to the court process in achieving property settlements.

Regional Family Dispute Resolution services offer families counselling sessions for specific issues related to separation and conflict.

To assist separated families experiencing high levels of conflict, the **Parenting Orders Program** consists of three main elements: parent group work, children's group work, and family counselling. The program focuses on skills to improve communication and manage conflict. It requires parents to commit to addressing their differences in the best interests of their children.

The **Children's Contact Service** enables children of separated families to re-establish or maintain contact with both parents or other family members where appropriate. It provides a safe, neutral and child-friendly environment for approved contact visits and children's changeovers.
