Support For Older People



There are times when individual circumstances change and there is a need for some time limited, or situational support to assist you to maintain living at home.

This may be the result of health decline, injury or other circumstances that reduce your functional capacity.



Short Term Support

Support Options provides assistance to people who are:

- eligible for government funded aged care services
- live within the Local Government Areas of Alpine, Benalla, Indigo, Mansfield, Towong, Wangaratta and Wodonga
- require one off or short term support.

Priority is given to those who require assistance with:

- personal care
- domestic assistance.



How to make a referral

To access support contact My Aged Care
Telephone 1800 200 422 or visit www.myagedcare.gov.au

Once My Aged Care has been contacted, a referral will be sent to an Assessment Service who will contact you prior to sending a referral to Support Options to organise services.

Where personal care is required immediately, My Aged Care can send a referral directly to Support Options for prompt implementation.

For private patients discharging from hospital, the hospital can undertake the referral to My Aged Care.
